

1st Place Behaviour Policy (Addendum)

After the above procedure has been applied, if a child continues to present challenging or dangerous behaviour thereby posing a danger to staff and children, the following steps will be taken;

1. Call the attention of the named behaviour lead or SENDco to provide additional support.
2. Keyworker or crèche staff records the occurrences of child's challenging behaviour.
3. Record in the behaviour log
4. If the child cannot be calmed down within the group, he / she will be taken to a separate room to reflect and calm down with the support of the behaviour lead or another manager.
5. If the child's behaviour escalates, the parent will be contacted and informed about their child's behaviour. A decision will be taken if the situation demands that the parent to be called in.
6. In the cases of persistent occurrence of challenging behaviour, the Behaviour lead manager will hold a meeting with the parent to explore causes of the child's behaviour and necessary interventions.
7. Where parents agree to explore intervention, the Behaviour Lead and Early Education Management will execute the process for any appropriate intervention necessary
8. Should the parent not wish to work in partnership we will discuss with the parent how they see us supporting their child.
9. When looking at needs of all children 1st Place will take appropriate safeguarding action as necessary.
